Small Group Discussion Guide – Sanctity of Human Life Sunday

Text: Psalm 139:13–18

Opening Prayer

Ask God for open hearts, humility, and compassion as you reflect on His Word and the value of human life.

Warm-Up

1. When you hear the phrase “handmade” or “crafted,” what comes to mind?
2. Have you ever seen something that made you stop and say, “That’s incredible”?

Scripture Reading

Read Psalm 139:13–18 together, listening for words that show God’s care and intention.

Observation

3. What words describe God’s activity in the womb?
4. What repeated personal language stands out?
5. What images are used to describe God’s work?
6. What does verse 16 reveal about God’s involvement before birth?

Interpretation

7. What does it mean that God knits and weaves a person?
8. How does this echo Genesis 2:7?
9. Why is human creation described as wonderful and awe-inspiring?
10. How does this passage speak to God’s sovereignty?

Application

11. How does this passage shape our view of human life?
12. How can Christians affirm life with both truth and compassion?
13. What is one way you can honor God’s handiwork this week?

Closing Prayer

Thank God for His creative work in every human life and ask for grace to live out His heart for life.
