Christian College/University Scholarship Fund

Purpose

The purpose of the Christian College Scholarship Fund is to encourage people to consider the value of a Christian education and to make such education affordable to the people of our church.

Who Administers the Fund

The Church Board or their designate oversees this fund.

Who is Eligible

More detailed information about eligibility can be found in the Christian College/University Scholarship Fund's policy and that document serves as the guiding document for this fund. A quick summary of eligibility follows below. Applicants for the scholarship must be:

- Regular attenders during the past year or working in the church's ministries,
- Enrolled in a Christian college or university,
- Have a GPA of at least a 2.00.

Application Information

There is an application that is available. It must be turned in prior to May 1 for funds in the following school year.

Funding

Anyone in the church may contribute to the fund. Applicants may contribute to the fund as well. However, applicants need to realize that monies given to the fund are non-refundable and are controlled by the Church Board. Monies cannot be designated to any specific student but are rather given to the Fund itself with the board or its designate overseeing dispersal of funds. Members outside the church are welcome to contribute as well.

Dispersal of Funds/Awards

The Church Board or its designate may allocate the funds as they deem fit. Several factors may be taken into account in the determination of the award amount. These factors include but are not limited to the applicant's financial need and the applicant's connection to Gospel Center. In general, the funds that are available will be divided evenly between applicants when the Board approves applications in its May meeting.

Checks will be made out to the institution that the applicant is attending. Notice will be made that the check is a scholarship on behalf of the student. The church, when possible, will have the checks ready to hand in to the colleges or universities before any matching scholarship are due.

What The Funds Can Be Used For

As funds can be considered taxable income if used for purposes other than current tuition, the scholarship will only cover current tuition costs and cannot be used to pay off student loan debts or room, board, books, and other similar fees.
